A remodelled space at the Digital Greenhouse will provide a Quiet Zone for the local business community, thanks to support from Sure.

The Quiet Zone was planned to open earlier in the year but delayed due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Now the Bailiwick is in phase 5, the Digital Greenhouse is open and welcoming members old and new.

Lucy Kirby, Director at the Digital Greenhouse, said: "We are very pleased to be adding this additional quiet space to our hotdesking now we are able to re-open to our members. Since lockdown caused us to work from home, we're expecting many users to need a quiet space away from the noise of home life.

"Of course digital enablement is at the heart of many businesses' strategies so this space, thanks to Sure's support, will be ideal for many of our members."
